

Reading Workshop

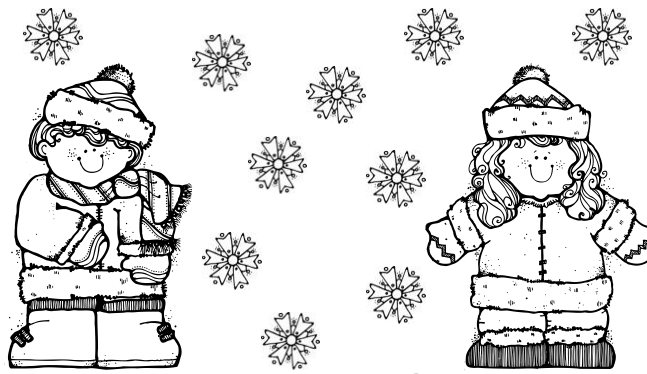
