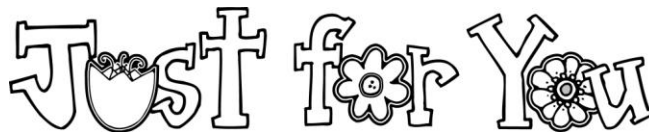

Math Concepts Covered

- + We will continue to strengthen our efficiency in solving both addition and subtraction word problems this week.
- + **At home, please have your child practice counting coins and telling time to the five minute intervals.**

For the next few weeks, students will not have a spelling word list, but instead will focus on learning rules we use in spelling when adding endings such as –ed and –ing.

1. **Drop e:** make + ing = making
2. **y to i:** cry + ed = cried
3. **double final consonant:**
run + ing = running
4. **no change:** jump + ing = jumping
